Regular Board Meeting

March 15, 2018

Opening

The Pickaway-Ross JVSD Board of Education met in Regular Session on Thursday, March 15, 2018, at 6:30 p.m. in the Board Conference Room at the Pickaway-Ross Career & Technology Center, 895 Crouse Chapel Road, Chillicothe, Ohio with Byron Lloyd, presiding.
