Regular Board Meeting

May 12, 2016

Opening

The Pickaway-Ross JVSD Board of Education met in Regular Session on Thursday, May 12, 2016, at 6:00 p.m. in the Board Conference Room at the Pickaway-Ross Career & Technology Center, 895 Crouse Chapel Road, Chillicothe, Ohio with Byron Lloyd, presiding.
