He also was active in the Chillicothe Jaycees, Chillicothe High School Athletic Booster, Tyler Methodist Church Food Kitchen, Goodwill Industries, Chillicothe Parks and Recreation, and Chillicothe Paints concession.

- This scholarship is available to a high school senior or college student wishing to further his/her education at a college, university, technical, vocational, or business school.
- The applicant must exhibit a positive attitude, demonstrate service to others, and have a G.P.A. of 2.5 or above.

The applicant must:

- Not have received a prior Lion Scholarship
- Submit an application postmarked no later than March 1, 2021.
- Submit an official high school or college transcript.
- Type a one page essay explaining why you should receive this scholarship. Describe or list ways in which you have contributed to your community, including volunteer work and activities.
- Submit one (1) recommendation from an organization or group where you performed community service.
