Memorial Law Enforcement Annual Scholarship 2021

Eligibility

Annual \$1000 scholarship for a Ross County/Chillicothe high school graduating senior or other qualified Ross County resident to attend Ohio University Chillicothe's Southern Ohio Police Training Institute (S.O.P.T.I.) or Law Enforcement Technology (L.E.T.) program.

Focus

Available to Ross County resident wishing to obtain education and training for a career in law enforcement.

Application Process

If applying to L.E.T., applicant must:

- * be a Ross County resident
- * have graduated from high school or be a graduating senior
- * provide an **official** high school transcript with a 2.5 G.P.A. and one (1) recommendation, either school personnel or a member of our community
- * type a one page essay explaining why you should be awarded this scholarship
- * complete application and mail to Lions postmarked no later than **March 1, 2021** for L.E.T. course beginning in fall semester

If applying for S.O.P.T.I., applicant must:

- * be a Ross County resident
- * if in US military, must have an honorable discharge prior to S.O.P.T.I. program
- * be 21 years of age by time of expected completion of S.O.P.T.I. program
- * provide complete military background and qualifications if applicable
- * provide educational and employment history
- * submit S.O.P.T.I. application postmarked no later than **March 1, 2021**.
- * type a one page essay explaining why you should be awarded this scholarship
